SCHOOL FEE CONTRIBUTIONS 2017

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian

Every year the Board discusses and sets the fee increment for the following year. Inflation is the key guide in the Board's deliberations along with the finances of the College. The Board is cognizant of the current economic climate and as such deliberated for a minimal increase for 2016. Comparatively speaking our fee is very competitive with other schools that offer a similar standard of education, and the Board is determined to maintain this competitive advantage where possible.

Sibling rebates have been reduced in line with a board decision to phase out sibling rebates over time. This is to support a minimal fee increase to all students.

Dates for paying the annual fees early and therefore qualifying for an early payment rebate have also been adjusted and two rebate dates have now been made available.

Our fee structure is that of an increasing fee amount as grades increase. Fees increase from contributions made in Grade R to contributions made for higher grades until Grade 12.

All monies are paid into Lebone II's ABSA bank current account directly or a debit order can be signed at the Finance office. Only card payments are received at the school, not cash nor cheques, etc.

All fees are payable monthly in advance before the 7th of each month for 11 months, January through to November. The monthly amounts payable are tabled under the monthly column below.

Boarding costs are payable per term in advance for each of the four terms or monthly in advance for 11 months.

Parents who wish to pay the total annual fees in advance need to do so by paying the full contributions before **31 December 2016 to qualify for a 7% rebate or by 31 January 2017 to qualify for a 4% rebate**. The total amount payable is tabled under the annual column below and rebates are **already** factored into these amounts.

The **Means and Needs** program is the only scholarship program at Lebone and needs to be applied for by parents who cannot afford the full fee contributions required. The application for the program is done through Lebone's Finance Office and requires parent(s)/guardians to submit the Means and Needs application form with supporting documents to be considered for further subsidy. Subsidies are dependent on family affordability, performance & behavior of the student/s attending and are re-evaluated every year.
